Sunday, November 7th GYMNASTICS DAY (\$35.00)

Gymnastics are used to improve the rider's position over jumps, build confidence in the rider and to teach the rider to use leg over obstacles. Gymnastics are a series of poles or jumps in a row that the rider progressively rides through. Groups will be divided by riding level and this is open to all levels of riders. Times will be e-mailed out to everyone.

****There will be a gymnastics portion of the Rider Level Test for levels 3 and up****
